<p>Each of us has a different interpretation of what a beginner rider/handler, an intermediate and an advanced individual is. It's all relative to what you're used to, and what you've been taught.</p> <p>Please follow our definitions below and rate your horse's rider minimum level requirement: _____</p> <p>Beginner: never ridden; ridden well trained, slow, or very forgiving horse; can sit the walk and trot, but may be uncomfortable or stiff due to even minimal fear of a sudden surprise; doesn't know leg, hand or weight cues well; Can lead a horse, but doesn't know what to do to discipline if the horse doesn't just follow along, or decides to go off in his own direction; would panic if a horse tried to pull away, rear or buck; screams or yells when a horse surprises them; doesn't know the rules of safety with regard to walking, standing beside, working around a horse.</p> <p>Advanced Beginner/Early Intermediate: knows leg and hand cues, some weight cues. Can sit all gaits relatively comfortably, but may not be able to balance a buck, or know what to do if a horse bolts; Hasn't developed enough strength in arms to hold a strong horse back; hasn't developed enough strength in legs to move an obstinate horse or hesitant horse forward; Knows leads; knows how to post; knows how to sit a horse that bucks, even if they aren't yet able to balance the movement well; may have started over cavelettis; knows safety with regard to handling, walking, working around horses; horse can do something that surprises them, but they don't get easily rattled, and can sit the issue through and know how to attempt to calm the horse.</p> <p>Intermediate: Knows cues well; can ride all gaits very comfortably; Can sit a buck; Can sit a rearing horse; knows what to do if holding a horse that rears; knows how to handle a horse that bites or kicks; has strength in arms to handle a strong horse, or stop a bolting horse; Has strength in legs to cue a non responsive horse; may have started jumping and can balance a jump comfortably; doesn't spook when the horse does and can immediately begin to calm a horse that is afraid; can anticipate changes in behavior when riding or handling a horse and knows how to react to maintain control of the situation.</p> <p>Advanced: Skilled professional. Can do all of the above and more.</p>

Horse Donation Agreement

I, _____, ("Donor") understand a donation is subject to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation's review and approval of this application. If this application is accepted, I understand and agree to the following:

- a) I transfer complete ownership of the Donated Horse to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation, which includes the care, custody and control of the horse, and the right to transfer ownership/registration to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation or to a person or organization adopting the Donated Horse. Prairie Fire Farms Foundation shall have sole and full discretion on the care and disposition of the Donated Horse, to include making decisions on veterinary treatment or procedures; adoption of the horse to persons or organizations deemed suitable by Prairie Fire Farms Foundation; or euthanasia. The Donated Horse is being transferred to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation in good and clear title, and free from any liens and/or encumbrances and/or financial obligations, including but not limited to training fees, breeding fees, boarding fee and/or veterinary bills.
- b) Donor will provide transport of the Donated Horse to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation's location or pre-pay for the transportation of the Donated Horse by Prairie Fire Farms Foundation at the rate of \$2.50 per loaded mile.
- c) Prairie Fire Farms Foundation shall not be responsible for any fees, including boarding fees. Prairie Fire Farms Foundation will not pay any fees to past providers, and **Donor will indemnify and hold Prairie Fire Farms Foundation harmless from any claim arising or lien arising from Donor's former ownership of the Donated Horse, including but not limited to negligence claims, common law liens, and/or any encumbrances. Donor warrants to reimburse Prairie Fire Farms Foundation for all reasonable legal fees incurred by Prairie Fire Farms Foundation related to the filing of any such claim.**
- d) Liability and risk of loss remains with Donor until Prairie Fire Farms Foundation is in actual possession of the Donated Horse.
- e) If the Donated Horse is a mare in foal, the offspring will become the exclusive property of Prairie Fire Farms Foundation.
- f) After acceptance of the delivery of the Donated Horse, Prairie Fire Farms Foundation will provide Donor with a receipt acknowledging possession of the horse. If Donor plans to take a tax deduction for the donation to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation, Donor will arrange for the valuation of the horse **in advance** of delivery to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation. Prairie Fire Farms Foundation is not able to provide an opinion on value. Donor shall provide Prairie Fire Farms Foundation with the valuation claimed for Donor's donation.
- g) Donor shall provide Prairie Fire Farms with the following documents **seven (7) days** prior to delivery of the Donated Horse. Failure to provide documents may result in termination of this Agreement by Prairie Fire Farms Foundation:
 1. Original Negative Coggins, no less than six months old;
 2. Written release for veterinary records of Donated Horse for all veterinarians used within last year OR full and complete copy of Donated Horse's veterinary records. Veterinary Records are to be released to and provided to Dr. Renee Nodine, Horseshoe Valley Equine, 177 Valley Lane, Annville, PA 17003.
 3. Health Certificate (if being transported across state lines to be dated within 30 days of transport)
 4. Registration papers for all registered horses. **For Thoroughbreds and Standardbreds, please write below the transfer, "Donated to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation, Inc. Not to be raced." And agrees to sign jockey form for execution through Prairie Fire Farms Foundation**
 5. Original bill of sale for Donated Horse (if available);
 6. Any additional comments you'd like to include about the horse you are donating.
 7. Payment for transport, if electing to have Prairie Fire Farms Foundation provide transportation.
- h) Shoes must be pulled from the Donated Horse unless shoes must remain for documented health reasons;
- i) All matters arising from this donation to Prairie Fire Farms Foundation will be construed under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and any action by either party shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in Lebanon County, Pennsylvania.
- j) This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties and there are no promises, agreements, representations or warranties other than those contained herein or expressly incorporated by reference. This Agreement may be amended in writing by the parties.
- k) I surrender all ownership interest in any additional property, as described above, that I am donating with the Donated Horse, including any tack, feed, grooming equipment, etc.
- l) I have not received anything of value from Prairie Fire Farms Foundation in exchange for the Donated Horse.

PRAIRIE FIRE FARMS FOUNDATION WILL NOTIFY YOU IN WRITING IF THE DONATED HORSE IS ACCEPTED. THIS AGREEMENT IS EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE BY PRAIRIE FIRE FARMS FOUNDATION.
